In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. Romans 8:26

The Spirit knows what to pray and \_\_\_\_\_ for us!

When Jude says to pray in the Holy Ghost, these things are implied:

1. Pray in the Spirit that you might be strengthened, encouraged, and comforted.

2. Pray in the Spirit that you might pray \_\_\_\_\_ when you do not know what to pray.

Why are tongues and prophecy so rare now when it was commonplace in the early church?
